- **The Secret Signal:** A clear ease-off is visible late in the race. Look for the jockey dropping their hands, putting the whip away, or sitting up tall in the saddle.

- **Full Tank:** The horse shows no signs of physical distress or fatigue. It looks like it still has plenty of gas left in the tank.

3. RED FLAGS! How to Dodge the Decoys

Now, pay attention. Not every horse that slows down is a target. The track is full of decoys designed to bleed your bankroll dry. These are the disqualifies that will get you **WASTED**. If you spot any of these red flags, you walk away. No exceptions.

- **Running on Fumes:** The horse was clearly exhausted and struggling *before* the jockey eased off.

5. Don't Be a Rookie: The Top 3 Screw-Ups to Avoid
